

2017 Central Wyoming Fair & Rodeo Parade Guidelines

The Central Wyoming Fair and Rodeo Parade will begin at 10:00am on Tuesday, Jul 11, 2017 in Downtown Casper. The Parade Committee designed the following guidelines to promote a parade that is fun, safe, and entertaining for everyone.

1. This year's theme is "The Central Wyoming Fair & Rodeo-"Stirrup Some Fun", **all entries** must incorporate the theme. This includes all cars & political entries.
2. Floats should arrive at their designated positions (see enclosure) by 9:00am
3. Follow the designated parade route (enclosed).
4. Parade participants should attend their entries at all times.
5. Allow 25 feet between entries.
6. If a preceding entry should stall, **DO NOT STOP**. Pull around that entry and close any gaps per Guideline 5 above.

Please **DO NOT** throw candy or other hand-outs from the floats or vehicles. Please distribute them at the curb in order to prevent the possibility of youngsters running into the street to "gather" the goodies, and getting injured.

The City has banned the following candy: Tootsie Rolls, Bubble Gum & Taffy, basically anything that is 'Sticky' makes it difficult for the street cleaning crew to remove.

7. Decorate vehicles in a manner that substantially alters the following characteristics:
 - a. Shape
 - b. Color
8. Exceptions to Guideline 8 include:
 - a. Towed decorated trailers
 - b. Qualified classic or antique automobiles
 - c. Special interest vehicles such as fire trucks, military vehicles, or group support vehicles.
9. Entry height is limited to twelve (12) feet.
10. **Absolutely** no spraying of water in the "No Quirt Zone" which will be located on Center Street between 6th & 7th Street. This includes squirt guns, fire hoses, water balloons, etc.

Officers from the Casper Police Department will be stationed along the parade route to monitor closed intersections, direct traffic and provide security. In order to enhance the safety of spectators and parade attendees, the Casper Police Department requests the following:

Those persons operating vehicles, floats and other motorized vehicles in the Parade are required to adhere to the following:

- Excessive engine noise, exhaust fumes and smoke is prohibited
- Exhibition of acceleration (squealing of tires) is prohibited
- Minors on motorcycles are required to wear a helmet

For those spectators along the route you are reminded to stay on the sidewalk and not enter the street during the parade. Do not set up chairs or stands in the street or crosswalks.
